THE PASSING OF VINCENT AQUILINA

Vincent Aquilina passed away peacefully at his home in Mississauga, Ontario on Sunday, September 28th.



Vincent Aquilina was born in Valletta, Malta, to Paul and Carmen Aquilina on November 27, 1937.

As a young man, he left Malta for England, where he spent over a decade. There, he developed a life-long passion for English football.

In this early 30s, Vince worked as a seaman aboard merchant ships.

In August 1972, in Malta, he married Mary Rose whom he had known since he was a teenager.

After spending a year in England, the couple migrated to Canada, where Mary Rose had previously lived.

Two children, Paula and David, were born to Vince and Mary Rose.

Both Vince and Mary Rose were longtime members of the Malta Band Club in Mississauga. Mary Rose has served on the Club's Committee for many years. In addition, she is currently co-producer of the weekly half-hour television program *Lehen Malti* from the Greater Toronto area.

The Mass celebrating Vince's life, took place on Saturday October 4, at St. Paul the Apostle Church.

He is survived by his wife, their two children and their spouses and four grandchildren. Vince was predeceased by his parents and two sisters, Lina and Freda.

A BUSY WEEK FOR THE MALTESE COMMUNITY ON THE EASTERN SEABOARD

The days between September 16th and September 22nd were particularly busy and exciting ones for the Maltese along America's Eastern Seaboard.

On Tuesday, September 16th, the Hon. Ian Borg, Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Foreign Affairs and Tourism, announced that Delta Airlines would be operating direct flights between New York's John F. Kennedy International Airport and Malta International Airport. The initial schedule will be three weekly flights using a Boeing 767-300 between June and October.

On the evening of Thursday, September 18th, in New York, the Malta Tourism Authority (MTA) hosted the U.S. premiere of *Hidden Malta*, a one-hour global television prime-time special. *Hidden Malta* is produced, hosted and narrated by CBS News Travel Editor and multiple Emmy Award-winning journalist Peter Greenberg.

This series will air this fall on PBS-TV and subsequently screen worldwide on Amazon Prime, Apple TV+ and YouTube.

The event was attended by distinguished guests, including the Hon. Ian Borg; Malta's Ambassador to the United States, Godfrey Xuereb; Malta's Permanent Representative to the United Nations, Natasha Meli-Daudey; MTA CEO Carlo Micallef; MTA Representative in North America, Michelle Buttigieg; and other MTA representatives and industry stakeholders.

The launch of the Malta Tourism Authority's North American Office in New York included such distinguished guests as the Hon. Ian Borg; Carlo Micallef; H.E. Godfrey Xuereb; H.E. Natasha Meli-Daudey; Consul General Denise Demicoli; and the incoming U.S. Ambassador to Malta, Somers Farkas. (See page 10.)

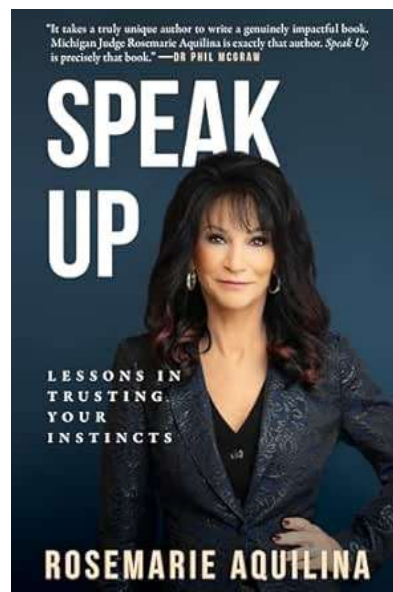

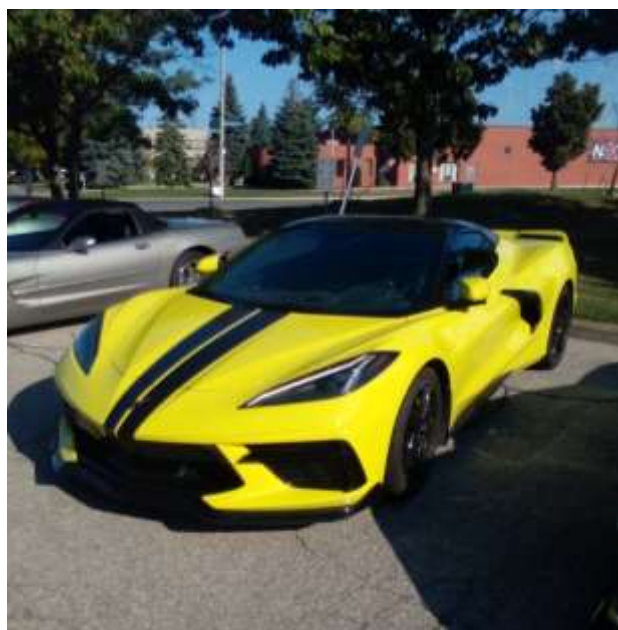

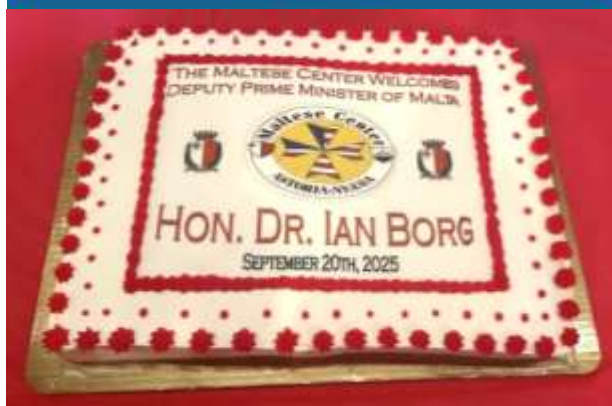

THE PASSING OF CHRISTINO GALEA

Christino Galea of Mississauga, Ontario, died on Tuesday, September 9th, in his 79th year. He is survived by his wife, three children and six grandchildren.



Christino was born in Manikata, a small settlement to the southwest of the village of Mellieha, Malta, on May 13, 1946. His parents were Pasquale and Carmela Galea. He had eight siblings: Frank, Michael, Joe, Gianni, Maria, Nina, Ann and Frances.

In 1965, at the age of 19, he migrated to Canada, intending to go to Calgary but ending up in Toronto.

He and MaryAnn, his wife of 50 years, were married in 1975. Together, they were to have three children: Christopher, Maria and Victoria.

Much of his career would be spent working for CN and Via. In his later years, he enjoyed spending time in the Junction at the local bakery, where he would socialize in the company of those dear to him. He would also go to the Melita Soccer Club for a Friday night dinner or for the special rabbit dinners.

Christino's Funeral Mass was celebrated at St. Paul the Apostle Church, Toronto, on Thursday September 18th. His burial took place at Assumption Catholic Cemetery, Mississauga.

JOE CONDORATO IS CALLED HOME TO GOD

Joseph Francis Condorato passed away in London, Ontario, on Wednesday, October 1st, one day short of his 88th birthday.



Joe was born in Cospicua, Malta on October 2, 1937.

He served for 10 years in the Royal Navy.

Joe met his future wife, Dolores "Doris" Gilford at the Café Riche in Cospicua and dancing "became a hobby for both." They were married in Senglea on April 19, 1958.

In 1966 they immigrated to London, Ontario, with their daughter, Monica. There, they were further blessed with a son, Kevin.

Joe and Doris' association with the now defunct Maltese Canadian Club of London goes back to its formation in 1977. When the Maltese folklore dance group was organized by the Club that fall, the Condoratos were one of 13 couples to join.

In addition to being a fine dancer, Joe was also a gifted painter. At top right is the backdrop he painted for the passion play *Gesu Ta' Nazzalett*, performed by Il-Maltese Actors of Toronto, on Good Friday, March 24, 1989 at the Club in London.



Several of Joe's works hung on the walls at the Club in London. The largest and the one I most admired was set in the wall of the lobby in front of the elevator of our club. We sold the building in 1918 and, regrettably, the new owners painted over this fine piece seen below.



The Funeral Mass for Joe was held on Tuesday, October 7th, at Holy Family Parish, on Valetta Street in London, with interment taking place at St. Peter's Cemetery.

Joe is survived by his wife, their two children and their spouses and three grandchildren.
