Please make sure you check the expiration date of your US passport and plan accordingly.

Origin of Maltese Last Names *Zahra*

Is your last name **ZAHRA?** If so, you may be interested on knowing where your last name comes from. **Zahra** is of Arabic origin. It comes from the Arabic word for "blossom", especially an orange blossom. In Maltese, we have the expression "Ilma Zghar", which translates to "orange blossom water" in English. In Arabic, it was also used as a pet name for a pretty girl. Although not as common as some surnames, it is an old name, dating back to at least the 15th century in Malta.

JULY IN MALTESE HISTORY



July 2, 1571 --- The parish of St. Dominic in Valletta is officially established, three months after the laying of the first stone. The Dominican-run parish replaces a small chapel which the Dominicans had administered previously. The present building is the second built on the same site, after the first structure is closed due to storm and earthquake damage. The new church, which opens around 1805, is raised to basilica status on March 25, 1816.

July 19, 1967 --- Malta and the Republic of China (Taiwan) establish diplomatic relations.

"I believe it is a major contribution to the history of the Maltese in our area. I have been working on this project for 5 years now, initially triggered by my being on the Maltese Historical Society." "It is based on public records available to anyone, listing births, marriages, deaths, and obituaries of all the Maltese people in the Bay Area from 1850 to the present. It now contains 10,000+ listings of Maltese individuals and is easily searchable. Partially, my request is in the hope that people may help me edit the duplicates that I may have in the database and to help me connect family relationships, where I have a married surname of a woman but not the maiden name. The California Birth index lists birth information under the woman's maiden name; here I need help discovering who the father is. My privacy policy is that I will remove any information that an individual requests. Any contributions, corrections and additions are welcome. Hope to hear."
