A MESSAGE FROM THE Honorable Consul General of Malta

At the November general membership meeting, Hon Consul General (HCG)-Louis J. Vella addressed those present during a commemorative event honoring Maltese veterans of the Korean War era.

HCG Vella told us that in order to fully comprehend the significance of the ceremony we were about to witness we needed to go back in time to 1939. Europe was at war. World War II began in 1939 and ended in 1945. After the Second World War, Malta was devastated. Not only buildings and other structures were destroyed but the infrastructure, the economy, jobs, food, fuel and everything necessary for people to live a decent life was gone, scarce, or non-existent. Young families had no choice but to seek a better future somewhere else. Many emigrated to the United States of America in search of a new life. No sooner many of these young Maltese men settled in the San Francisco Bay Area when in 1950, the war in Korea broke out. A large number of Maltese boys and young men got drafted into one of the branches of the US Military.

On Sunday, November 29th in the presence of the Consulate General of Korea, the California State Senate and the Hon Consulate General of Malta, many guests, and veterans, a celebration of the sacrifice and commitment of some of these men was held. Close to 30 veterans or their families were honored with certificates, medals and a lot of admiration presented to them by the Hon Consul General of Malta, the Deputy Consul General of Korea and the office of State Senator Jerry Hill in the presence of a crowd that exceeded well over 200 people.

Huge congratulations go to the members of the Maltese Historical Society for their dedicated work, enthusiasm and their tireless efforts to find these veterans. A big thank you goes to the Maltese American Social Club, the Consulate General of Korea, the Hon Consulate General of Malta and everyone present.

The spirit of cooperation and support among the entire Maltese American Community in the San Francisco Bay Area as well as all the Maltese organizations is second to none. Very Well Done Everyone.

THIS MONTH IN MALTESE HISTORY

IN MALTESE HISTORY

November 23, 1985 - An Egyptian Airlines plane on a flight from Athens to Cairo is hijacked and lands in Malta at 10 p.m. On board are 91 passengers and 6 crew members.

November 2011 - A census is held in Malta, the results of which show a 2.7% increase in population from 2005, from 404,962 to 416,055.





Is your last name <u>Busuttil</u>? If so, you might be interested in knowing where your name comes from. **Busuttil** is of Arabic origin. It is a personal name or a nickname coming from the Arabic word "busittin", which means "master of sixty."
