Origin of Maltese Last Names Pulis

Is your last name <u>Pulis</u>? If so, you may be interested in knowing where your last name comes from. <u>Pulis</u> is a shortened form of the Italian place-name "Pulisi" or "Polisi." It refers to an area in the province of Palermo in Sicily. A form of this name existed in Sicily as early as the 12th century.

JANUARY IN MALTESE HISTORY by Mona Vella-Nicholas, Librarian and Historian

January, 1942--- Three merchant ships sail from Tripoli in Libya carrying 2,000 Maltese men, women, and children. Because Malta is a British possession, these people are being deported to Italy, where they will spend the next three years as enemy civilians. When the war is over, they are allowed to return to Tripoli; however, their return adds insult to injury, as they find that nothing is left of their property or other belongings. Many leave North Africa for good, choosing to start afresh in Australia or Canada rather than starting over in Libya.

January, 2008--- Malta joins the Eurozone, four years after joining the European Union. The Eurozone is the monetary arm of the EU. The nineteen EU countries who belong to the Eurozone have adopted the euro as their national currency. Nine additional countries are members of the EU but not of the Eurozone, having chosen to keep their own traditional currency (for example, the Swiss franc) instead.
