



DECEMBER IN MALTESE HISTORY by Mona Vella-Nicholas

December 20, 1522--- After a nearly 6-month siege of the island fortress of Rhodes, the Ottoman forces successfully defeat the defending Knights of Rhodes. Their numbers decimated by the long siege, the Knights are forced to surrender. The ruler of the Ottoman Empire, Suleiman the Magnificent, aged 28 at the time, expels the surviving Knights. They leave Rhodes, wandering for a time until they finally settle in Malta, developing their new stronghold into another island fortress and becoming forever known as the Knights of Malta wo campaigns alone, the Salonika and Gallipoli campaigns, 136,121 sick and wounded soldiers and sailors are treated in Malta. Numerous buildings are destroyed by the 30-ft. rise in the sea level and 200,000 people are killed. The quake hits Malta at 5:21 in the morning, followed by several aftershocks. As happened in Sicily, the waters rise, flooding the city of Msida for eight hours. Once the waters recede, eyewitnesses describe fish "wriggling in the sand" on what is once again dry land.
