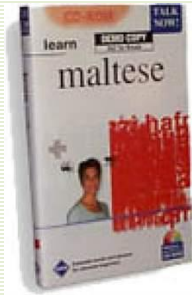

Origin of Maltese Last Names

Porter

It is an occupational name, referring to a doorkeeper or gatekeeper. In Medieval times, it also referred to someone who carried or transported goods from one place to another. It comes from the Latin noun "portarius", meaning "door" and the Latin verb "portare", meaning "to carry."

December 20, 1850 --- A child is born to Isabella Abela of Rabat, Gozo. The infant dies of a hemorrhage shortly after birth. Two months later, on February 14th, 1851, Isabella is charged with infanticide. The prosecution argues that she brought about the baby's death by not tying the umbilical cord properly after birth. She is accused of negligence and the prosecutor asks for the death penalty. The charge is later changed to burying the infant after death. The defense attorney argues that Isabella had not buried the child, but simply placed it under a box. The child's body is found inside the house and not buried, so the jury finds Isabella not guilty. She is the first woman in the 19th century to be charged with infanticide in Malta.

December 11, 2015 --- Antoine Borg Micallef writes an article stating that there are seven reasons why the Gozo Tunnel Project is a bad idea. The major reason he gives is that the rural and tranquil nature of Gozo will become more of a Malta, with its bustling lifestyle. In spite of this reservation and that of numerous others, Parliament approves the Malta-Gozo tunnel link in April, 2019. In August, bids for building and operating the tunnel are opened. The tunnel is expected to be operational by 2024.
