# A MESSAGE FROM THE Honorable Consul General of Malta

Mr. Vella began his address by continuing on a previous presentation during the meeting that mentioned a brief period of history when the French occupied Malta. HC Vella, as a matter of interest, mentioned that a marble statue of the bust of the French Emperor, Napoleon Bonaparte, can still be found today in the office of the Malta Minister of Foreign Affairs in Palazzo Parisio on Merchant Street in Valletta.

Mr. Vella talked about the successful Bocce Ball tournament held the day before, organized by the Maltese Historical Society. It was very well attended and a lot of fun. Talks have already started to find ways on how to continue to improve this annual event.

Malta on the conditions and the progress of these tragic events. Although Malta cannot do much to protect Maltese or Maltese Americans affected by these horrific events, nevertheless, it is a demonstration of solidarity, care and thoughtfulness which is immensely appreciated by victims or those who are displaced by these tragic incidents. HC Vella has reached out to several Maltese & Maltese American families in the region, most of whom had already or were in the process of evacuating. Many homes and other structures were already destroyed by the devastating fires but thankfully, up until Sunday, there were no reports of injuries or loss of lives. Prayers and all kinds of assistance are desperately needed.

Mr. Vella talked to us about a good friend, Mr. Alfred Rapa, who sadly passed away a few days prior. We fondly remember Alfred Rapa, who at one time, was very popular in Malta in the 1970's and 80's when his songs were played regularly on local radio. Alfred also made a number of appearances on TV Malta and he participated in a number of song festivals. One year, Alfred Rapa won the prestigious Malta Song Festival with a very melodious song he composed himself. This was probably the highlight of his entire successful singing career. Alfred continued to entertain many Maltese communities in the US and Canada. Mr. Vella told us that he is working with the main TV Station in Malta to do a special feature about Alfred Rapa, his life and his music.



## OCTOBER IN MALTESE HISTORY

October 28, 1798 --- Four months after invading the Maltese Islands and expelling the Knights of Malta, the French surrender Gozo to the English under Captain Alexander Ball. Rather than taking over governance of the island, Ball turns it over to the Gozitans, who establish self-government, independent of Malta. Gozo continues to be an independent island for two years, rejoining Malta only once the sister island becomes a British Protectorate in 1800.

October, 1853 --- The Crimean War begins, pitting the British, French, and Turks against the Russian Empire. Malta serves as a hospital island for injured British soldiers and sailors. The casualties are treated in one of four military hospitals located on the island, but the numbers of those needing treatment are so overwhelming as to make the existing accommodations inadequate. Only after the Crimean War ends in 1856 are the necessary expansions made.

# Origin of Maltese Last Names Pirotta

Is your last name <u>Pirotta</u>? If so, you may be interested in knowing where your last name comes from. <u>Pirotta</u> is the feminine singular form of the Italian last name"Pirotti." It is a diminutive form of the last name "Piro." Diminutives are like saying "Johnny" instead of "John", for example. "Piro" is in turn a form of "Pietro", or "Peter" in English
