THIS MONTH IN MALTESE HISTORY

IN MALTESE HISTORY

This is the last in our series commemorating the 450th anniversary of the Great Siege. Although these final events occurred in September, not October, they give closure to the most unique historical event in our history.

September 12, 1565. On the same day that the Ottoman Turks leave Malta after their defeat, the Spanish relief force has a chance to observe the damage inflicted upon the island and its people. These soldiers are overwhelmed by the destruction they find. Besides massive destruction of property, the toll in terms of human life is incredible. Here is the list of casualties on our side:

Of the 500 knights protecting the island, 300 have been killed. Of the soldiers of all nationalities who came to fight alongside the knights, 2,500 have been killed.

Of the Maltese men, women, and children on the island, 7,000 have been killed.

Of the slaves of the knights, 500 have been killed.

September 17, 1565 - The surviving foreign soldiers who had fought in the siege are taken back to Sicily in five ships belonging to the Knights of Malta. The siege is officially over, the reconstruction of lives and property begins.....

Origin of Maltese Last Names

"Bucelli", in turn, is the plural form of the word "bucello", which means "calf." It can therefore be assumed that the name refers to someone who herded calves.
