## A MESSAGE FROM THE Honorable Consul General of Malta

Greetings and best wishes for good health and happiness to all our fellow members of the Maltese Club and the Maltese-American Community in California.

September is always a special month for the Maltese-American community in the San Francisco Bay Area. In September we celebrate Malta Day. A nice group of Maltese Club members and friends made a trip to the City upon the invitation of the office of protocol of the mayor of the San Francisco. The experience started near the Civic Center Bart station where we visited the granite columns and discussed the significance of the name of Malta chiseled on one of the columns to commemorate when Malta was admitted as a member of the United Nations in 1964. Afterwards the group walked to City Hall and gathered under the dome of the rotunda where we shared stories and history of San Francisco and events that took place at the iconic structure. The group proceeded to climb the majestic stairs and on to the mayor's office where we were greeted by staff of the mayor. With the Maltese National Anthem playing in the background, the flag of Malta was hoisted slowly and proudly up the flagpole from the balcony of the office of the mayor overlooking UN plaza. The group was invited to a champagne reception inside the famous international room where a beautiful display of artifacts and memorabilia from many different countries, including Malta, are housed behind glass

Everyone had a wonderful time and it was indeed a very memorable occasion which was captured in dozens of photos. In 2022 it will be the 58<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the first Malta day on September 21<sup>st</sup> 1964 when Malta gain its independence and the Maltese community looks forward to another wonderful celebration at San Francisco City Hall.

**UN General Assembly:** Every year in September, all the leaders of all the countries in the world gather in New York to participate in the United Nations General Assembly. The US president addressed the assembly and so did the prime minister of Malta. Visiting from Malta there was also the minister of foreign affairs, who is also the chairperson of the council of Maltese living abroad. This council is the body that encompasses the interests of all those who are of Maltese descent living outside of Malta.

Valletta: The capital city of Malta has an ambitious plan to become the first city in Malta to gain the designation as a "Green City" This would mean that the carbon footprint of the city will need to be lowered to a level that will qualify the city as green. Some of the measures that are being proposed are to increase pedestrian areas, reduce fossil fuel cars that are allowed to enter the city, make public transportation within the city battery operated, give incentives to car owners to replace their fuel operated cars to electric powered vehicles, increase rooftop gardens and solar energy and many other measures. The target year is 2030. It will be so different visiting our capital city when Maltese living abroad visit the city built "*by gentlemen for gentlemen*"




### Women's Social Committee

## SEPTEMBER IN MALTESE HISTORY

**September 11, 2001** --- Brian Joseph Cachia has just settled down to work as a technical support specialist for Cantor Fitzgerald. His office is on the 103rd floor in the North Tower of the World Trade Center. His grandfather, Joseph, is a Maltese immigrant from Zabbar. His parents are Joe and Sabrina Cachia. At 8:46 a.m., American Airlines flight 11 from Boston, bound for Los Angeles, crashes into the North Tower a few floors below where Brian is working. He does not survive, becoming the only person of Maltese descent to die in the terrorist attack. He is 26 years old.

September 11, 2001 --- Anthony Gurrera, a New York City firefighter, has the day off. He is of Maltese descent on his mother's side. His grandparents are Joseph and Grace Galea of Zejtun. His parents are Anthony Gurrera and Catherine Galea Gurrera. He is at home listening to the radio when he hears that a plane has crashed into the World Trade Center. Anthony immediately goes to his firehouse, where he joins his fellow firefighters in rushing to the scene of the attack. When one of the two towers collapses, seven of the firefighters from Anthony's firehouse are killed, but Anthony survives. He is 33 years old.
